## Parent Participation at KCC

Kids' Cooperative Cambridge depends on the active participation of parents as caregivers weekly, plus their additional job roles to help run coop. Before you apply, please do consider this list of commitments below and consider if you are able to commit to this level of involvement in our coop preschool community.

- Parents work as caregivers in the classroom one day per week
- Perform an on-going parent job role throughout the year
- Provide an organic fruit or vegetable snack every 3 weeks
- Attend General meetings/cleaning nights, 2 hours each, once per month
- May also serve as part of our 5-person board, with additional meetings every 6-8 weeks
- Communicate regularly with the group using the Slack app and email
- Ideally, caregivers will have the flexibility to swap work shifts with others as needed
- \$500 tuition fee per semester
